Short Description of Activity Conducted:-

Department of Zoology & Botany celebrated 'Wildlife week', on 05th of October 2019 by conducting two competitions namely 'Wildlife photography competition' & 'Floral Rangoli decoration' for all the students of college and a lecture on 'Biodiversity of Western Ghats' along with 'wildlife video show' by Mr. Raman Kulkarni.

1. In the morning at 09.00 am to 10.00 am the students from Arts, Commerce and Science arranged their photos shot with the Mobiles, Cameras and DSLRs for the 'Wildlife photography competition'. For the competition the photos were decoratively presented along with short description of the object (plant, animal, nature, etc.), Slogan about the photo and information of camera. Total 19 participants displayed their photos in the competition.

The 'Floral Rangoli decoration' was also arranged by 41 groups of students. The students used only parts of plants like leaves, flowers, roots and stems.

2. Inauguration of the programme was conducted at 10.30 am to 12.00 pm. Mr. Raman Kulkarni and Mrs. Sonali Konduskar were the chief guest for the inauguration function. The programme was chaired by I/c Principal, Mr. A. H. Nikam. In the inauguration ceremony, Mrs. Sonali Konduskar talked about the importance of celebration of wildlife week. She also spoke on importance of wildlife for the society,

conservation of the biodiversity and the career opportunities for the life science students in dept. of forest.

- 3. In second session at 12.15 pm to 02.00 pm another resource person, Mr. Raman Kulkarni spoke on the 'biodiversity of Western Ghats'. He explained about the rich biodiversity of Western Ghats, its importance in the wildlife, causes of destruction of biodiversity and strategies for its preservation and conservation.

- 5. After lunch break, at 02.30 to 03.30 the video show of 03 documentaries on wildlife, shot by Mr. Raman Kulkarni was arranged for the students.
- 6. The valedictory programme was conducted in presence of Mr. Raman Kulkarni. The programme was chaired by Mr. D. G. Jagtap, Head, Dept. of Botany. The winners of the both competitions were felicitated in the programme.
