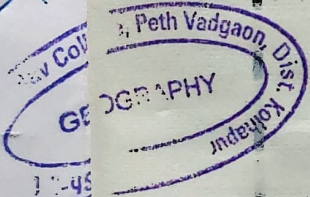

A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:

**Shri Vijaysinha Yadav College, Peth Vadgaon, Tal. Hatkanangale,
Dist. Kolhapur (MS) - 416112.**

Shri Vijaysinha Yadav College, Peth Vadgaon: A symbol of quality education for social, economical and cultural reformation. Our institution is a live monument of Vijaysinha Balawantrao Yadav, the man of vision.

Shri Vijaysinha Yadav College was established in 1999 specially to provide quality education to the students from Peth Vadgaon and surrounding rural area under the roof of Shri Shahu Shikshan Prasarak Seva Mandal. This educational Institute has created employment and made the economic and socio-cultural development of the neighbouring area. The College is situated in semi urban area. The college offers various academic programmes in Arts, Commerce and Science. The College strives for excellence in all its activities, which is authenticated by the fact that the college is accredited with Grade: B++ (CGPA: 2.83) by NAAC, Bangalore.

The **Vivekanand College, Kolhapur (Autonomous)** will be an educational centre devoted to the dissemination of "**Education for Knowledge, Science and Culture.**" which was established in 1964 is known as one of the best quality colleges in Maharashtra. The U.G.C. granted autonomy to this college from the academic year 2018-19. About 8000 students are enrolled every year for various programmes. Besides the conventional programmes like B. A., B. Com. and B. Sc., the college offers the professional programmes like B. B. A., B. C. A., B. C. S., B. Sc. (Biotechnology), B. Sc. Microbiology, B. Voc., Community College and M. B. A. The college also provides opportunity to undertake degrees like B. A., B. Com., B. Sc., B. Lib., M. Lib. and M.B.A. of YCMOU, Nashik.

Considering the strengths of the college, the NAAC, Bangalore has recredited the college with 'A' Grade. The college is identified twice as the "College with Potential for Excellence" by the UGC, and included in "The Star College Scheme" by the DBT, Govt. of India.

The Second Party is promoted by

- C) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- D) The Parties intent to co-operate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training and Education.
- E) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MoU for advancing their mutual interests.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MoU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Clause 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First and Second Party to providing or exchange significant inputs to each other for developing suitable teaching / skill training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the pure academic purpose.
- 1.3 Strengthening institutions to produce high quality students for better employability.
- 1.4 Scaling-up UG Education and Demand-Driven Research & Development and Innovation.
- 1.5 Establishing Centers of Excellence for focused applicable research Training of faculty for effective Teaching.
- 1.6 Enhancing institutional effectiveness.
- 1.7 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MoU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MoU shall represent the entire understanding as to the



subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

Clause 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness in different sectors of society. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 **Curriculum Design:** Both first and Second Party will give valuable inputs to teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the different sectors meaningfully.
- 2.3 **Research and Development:** Both First and Second Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of Geography.
- 2.4 **Skill Development Programs:** Both First and Second Party to train the students on the GIS, GPS, Remote Sensing, Cartography, Surveying, Soil and Water Assessment, Travel and Tourism techniques in order to bridge the skill gap and make them ready for the future employment.
- 2.5 **Guest Lectures:** Both First and Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First and Second Party.
- 2.6 **Exchange of Students:** Both First and Second Party to extend the necessary support to exchange of the students for academic programmes.
- 2.7 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein.
- 2.8 There is no financial commitment in both First and Second Party on the part of to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

Clause 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

Clause 4 VALIDITY

4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MoU.

4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MoU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

Clause 5 RELATIONSHIPS BETWEEN THE PARTIES


5.1 It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MoU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.


Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First and Second Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of **Kolhapur**.


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
