#### **Report on Shramdan Activity at Library Campus, Shri Vijaysinha Yadav College, Pethvadgaon**

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#### **Introduction:**

On **21st December 2023**, the **National Service Scheme (NSS)** unit of **Shri Vijaysinha Yadav College, Pethvadgaon**, organized a **Shramdan** (cleanliness drive) at the **Library Campus** of the college. 3. **Cleaning of Surroundings:** In addition to waste collection, students worked on sweeping pathways, clearing debris, and cleaning around the library building. This task was aimed at making the area not only cleaner but also safer and more visually appealing for students and staff who use the library for study and academic purposes.
4. **Teamwork and Coordination:** The volunteers were divided into smaller groups, each responsible for cleaning specific areas of the library campus.

Working in teams allowed the students to organize their efforts efficiently, complete tasks quickly, and foster a spirit of collaboration. It also helped in managing the large number of participants, ensuring that the work was done systematically.

Patil** addressed the students and provided a brief session on the importance of cleanliness, waste management, and the detrimental effects of plastic pollution. The coordinators encouraged the students to carry forward the lessons learned in the event to their daily lives and promote cleanliness within their communities.
6. **Faculty Participation:** Faculty members, including **Dr. S. P. Patil** and **Dr. D. J. Bhandare**, were present throughout the activity, actively participating and overseeing the work. Their presence motivated the students and helped ensure that the tasks were carried out effectively. They also offered guidance on waste segregation and provided moral support to the volunteers.

### **Outcomes and Impact:**

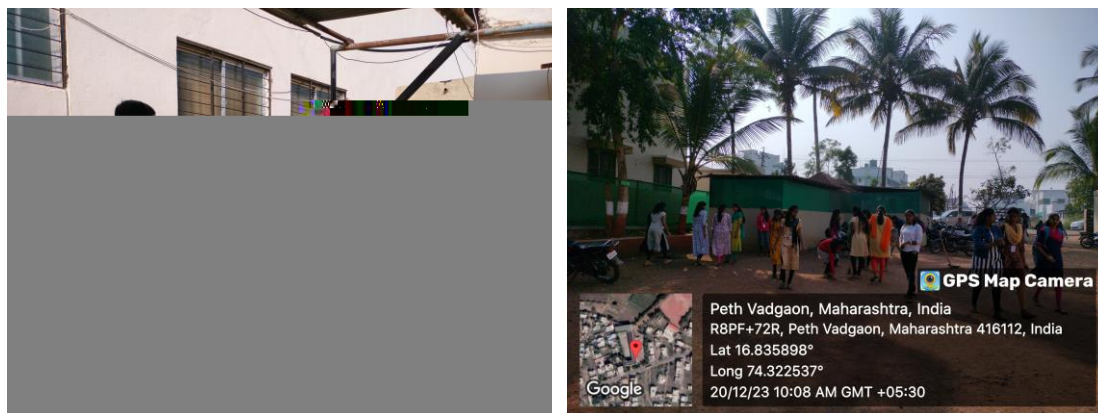

## Conclusion:

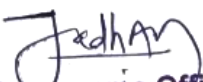

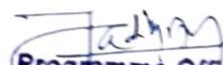
